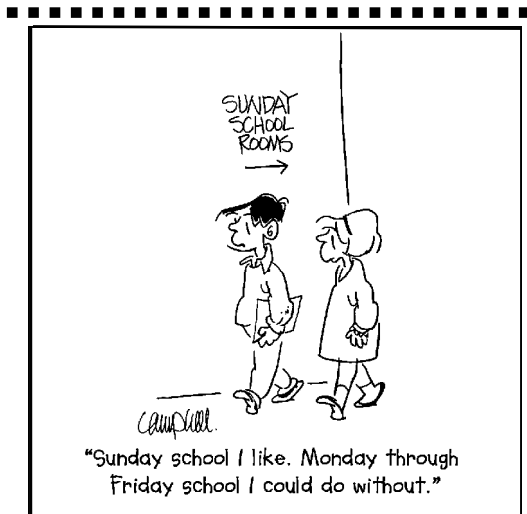

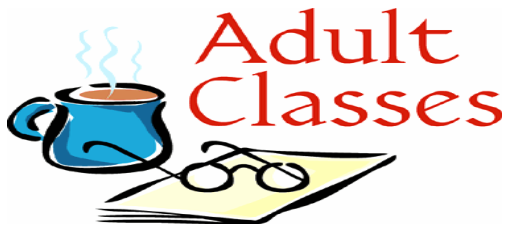

**Agapé** (Room 13) ~ Applying the truth of the Bible to deal with life in a secular world. Topics are chosen each September and have included morals, marriage, salvation, aging and the trinity.

**Wesley** (Fellowship Hall) ~ The Methodist “Adult Bible Series” books are used as a springboard for discussion and a structured study of how the scriptures apply to everyday life.

**Christian Roundtable** (Parlor) ~ This discussion group is lead by rotating class members. Past books include *How Good Do We Have To Be* and *The Purpose Driven Life*.

**Women’s Book Study** (Room 6) ~ A book discussion group for women. Previously have read and discussed *The Shack* by Wm Paul Young.



Confirmation is a very important step in our faith journey and a very large commitment. For United Methodists, it is a time of preparation leading to the first public profession of faith. “During this time young people are asked to “make firm” what has gone before: God’s prevenient grace, baptism, the teaching and witness of parents and other persons of faith, the teachings and life together in the church, the student’s own growing faith” (claimthename.com).

Confirmation Class begins April 11<sup>th</sup> during the Sunday School hour for all 6<sup>th</sup> graders and above who haven’t been confirmed. Confirmation will be held on Pentecost Sunday, May 23, 2010.

## Youth Classes



**Junior/Senior High** (grades 6-12) in Room 1

~ Focused on discussion & encouragement to help teens make decisions based on the life of Christ.

~ Topics are chosen in a mutual agreement between teacher and students, and include all current issues facing today’s youth. The class is presented as an open forum with no homework or assignments.



*The curricula used by the Children’s Classes is Cokesbury’s Live B.I.G. and Rock Solid.*

**Third to Fifth Grade** (Room 4) — The goal of this class is to nurture and educate young Christians. The lessons use biblically based stories, short plays, crafts, puzzles and real life experiences.

**First & Second Grade** (Room 10) — Old and New Testament stories are applied to real life. Students learn to use their own Bibles while looking up memory verses.

**Preschool through Kindergarten** (Room 9) — A fun, age appropriate introduction to the Bible, this class consists of free play, a bible story crafts, and snacks. They also learn to share joys and concerns. In addition, the children participate in a Wee Sing lesson with the Choir Director and perform in church every month that has a 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday.
